A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the Georgia Cattlemen's Association for uniting and advancing Georgia's cattle
2 industry; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, March 3, 2017, is Georgia Cattlemen's Association Day at the state capitol; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Georgia Cattlemen's were founded and established in 1961; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the Georgia Cattlemen's have grown to 65 local chapters with more than 5,500
6 members around the state; and
- 7 WHEREAS, they are led by their President, Kyle Gillooly of Wadley, Georgia; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the cattle industry has a \$1 billion farm gate value in the State of Georgia; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the cattle industry has a \$4 billion economic impact in the State of Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, there are 15,000 cattle producers in the State of Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, there are cattle being produced in every county in the State of Georgia.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
13 recognize the Georgia Cattlemen's Association for uniting and advancing Georgia's cattle
14 industry.
