

The Senate Committee on Public Safety offered the following substitute to SB 169:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 special license plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, causes, agencies,
3 or nonprofit corporations, so as to establish a specialty license plate honoring law
4 enforcement; to provide for related matters; to provide for compliance with constitutional
5 requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

7 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
8 plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, causes, agencies, or nonprofit
9 corporations, is amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as follows:
10

11 "(55) A special license plate honoring Georgia law enforcement officers, with the words
12 'back the badge' to be displayed across the bottom. The funds raised by the sale of this
13 special license plate shall be disbursed to the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund."

SECTION 2.

14 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph (VI)(n) of the
15 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
16 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

SECTION 3.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
