A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending George Romberg on his outstanding public service; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, George Romberg has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the
4 vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by his superlative service with the Gainesville Rotary Club; and

9 WHEREAS, George first joined the Gainesville Rotary Club in 1967 and has maintained
10 perfect attendance for 50 years, setting a record for the club which his father, Conrad
11 Romberg, previously held; and

12 WHEREAS, he boasts one of the outstanding attendance records for Rotary District 6910 and
13 Rotary International; and

14 WHEREAS, George served as president of the Gainesville Rotary Club from 1977-1978,
15 succeeding Governor Nathan Deal who had been president from 1976-1977; and

16 WHEREAS, this civic and community leader has been recognized for his outstanding service
17 to the community through numerous awards, including the Sidney O. Smith Fellowship
18 Award, and he is a Will Watt Fellow and Paul Harris Fellow; and

19 WHEREAS, despite being heavily involved in the Gainesville Rotary Club, George also
20 found time to serve with the Gainesville Jaycees and the United Way, and he and his wife,
21 Sandra, have been active in their church, Gainesville First United Methodist Church; and

22 WHEREAS, George's significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable
23 patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the
24 citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his peers; and

25 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
26 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

27 WHEREAS, George has served with honor and distinction with the Gainesville Rotary Club,
28 and his vision and unyielding commitment to serving others have set the standard for public
29 service; and

30 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
31 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
33 recognize and commend George Romberg for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
34 public service to the Gainesville community and the State of Georgia.
