A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending President Donald J. Trump; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the President of the United States, as the commander-in-chief, acted responsibly
3 and in full commitment to the Oath of Office by ordering a comprehensive review of the
4 security procedures and measures governing entry into the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, there is no greater responsibility to the citizens of this nation than ensuring the
6 safety of American lives; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it is imperative that our nation takes all available precautions to protect against
8 potentially radical organizations and individuals, which seek to inflict harm against
9 Americans on both foreign and domestic soil; and
- 10 WHEREAS, we are constantly reminded of the radicalized threats that exist in the world, and
11 which seek only to inflict damage and acts of terror on humankind; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the President of this nation to offer leadership in
13 securing its borders and to ensure the safety of all its citizens.

15 recognize and commend President Donald J. Trump for his honorable, bold and courageous
16 public service to keep the State of Georgia and the United States safe.
