

Senators Ligon, Jr. of the 3rd and Tillery of the 19th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and the Environment substitute to SB*  
 2 *191 (LC 36 3343S) by striking line 12 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

 4 of coal ash in certain vital areas; to provide for related

5 *By inserting between lines 142 and 143 the following:*

**SECTION 2.**

6 Said title is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

7 "12-8-24.4.

8 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'coal combustion residuals' means fly ash,  
 9 bottom ash, boiler slag, and flue-gas desulfurization materials generated from burning coal  
 10 for the purpose of generating electricity by electric utilities and independent power  
 11 producers.

12 (b) On and after July 1, 2017, no disposal of coal combustion residuals in any municipal  
 13 solid waste landfill located within the ground-water recharge area of the Floridan aquifer  
 14 shall occur."

 16 *By redesignating Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 as Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, respectively.*
