## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Devra Proctor Walker; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Devra Proctor Walker on February 23, 2017; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Devra Proctor Walker was born on January 31, 1961, a beloved daughter of  
5 Emerson and Uldine Proctor; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Devra was an active member of Statesboro  
7 Primitive Baptist Church, where she sang in the choir and was a member of the T. Roe Scott  
8 Bible Study Class; and
- 9 WHEREAS, she was united in love and marriage to her husband, Roswell Lindsay Walker,  
10 Jr., and was blessed with three remarkable sons, Jordan, Brandon, and Griffin, and one  
11 wonderful granddaughter, Emerson; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Devra graduated at the top of her class from the University of Georgia with a  
13 master's degree in accounting, practiced as a Certified Public Accountant until 1992, and also  
14 helped her husband build a successful company; and
- 15 WHEREAS, a public servant who dedicated her time, talents, and energy toward the  
16 betterment of her community, Devra served in various leadership roles for groups such as the  
17 Statesboro Service League and the Development Authority; and
- 18 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
19 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
20 her family and friends were admired by others; and

21 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
22 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,  
23 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

24 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Devra will long be remembered for her  
25 love of family and friendship and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing  
26 her.
