A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Vivian Moore on her outstanding public service; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Vivian Moore has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital
4 role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare of
5 the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her community and state as evidenced
8 dramatically by her superlative service with the East Lake Foundation; and

9 WHEREAS, the East Lake Foundation works with residents and expert public and private
10 partners to provide comprehensive programs and facilities that attract people of all ages and
11 incomes seeking a sense of community; and

12 WHEREAS, the foundation helps families build better lives and children reach their highest
13 potential through its holistic approach to community revitalization, incorporating
14 mixed-income housing, cradle-to-college education, and community wellness; and

15 WHEREAS, Vivian joined the East Lake Foundation from the West End Medical Center,
16 where she was a certified application assistant counselor for the Affordable Health Care Act
17 and a recruiter to the state's PeachCare program, and she now serves as a family health
18 advocate for the foundation; and

19 WHEREAS, she is extensively involved in her community outside of the East Lake
20 Foundation, serving as the second vice chairperson for the League of Women Voters
21 Membership, chairperson for the Southern Freemen Fund Scholarship Committee,
22 membership chairperson for the Atlanta Cancer Awareness Partnership, and NAACP State

23 District 4 Coordinator, and formerly served as the president of the DeKalb NAACP and
24 coordinator for the DeKalb NAACP Community Coordinator Committee; and

25 WHEREAS, Vivian's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
26 patience and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the
27 citizens of this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and
28 associates; and

29 WHEREAS, Vivian has served with honor and distinction with the East Lake Foundation,
30 and her vision and unyielding dedication have set the standard for public service; and

31 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
32 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
34 recognize and commend Vivian Moore for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
35 public service to the State of Georgia and extend the most sincere best wishes for continued
36 health and happiness.
