20 WHEREAS, Lynn has served with honor and distinction with Gwinnett Habitat for
21 Humanity, and her vision and unyielding commitment to public service will be sorely missed

23 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
24 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.
