18 Mrs. Global Humanitarian for her work and representation for the United States of America
19 on the global stage, and throughout her reign, she will continue her work on making sure that
20 every American has health insurance, provide food and water supplies to those in need,
21 evangelize to the masses, and supply medical equipment and other necessities across the
22 seas; and

24 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
