A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Linda Keeney on the grand occasion of her retirement; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, after more than three decades of teaching, including ten years as Principal of
4 King Springs Elementary, Linda Keeney retired from the Cobb County School System on
5 February 6, 2017; and

6 WHEREAS, she received a bachelor's degree in special education from West Georgia State
7 University and a master's degree in both special education and leadership; and

8 WHEREAS, she has taught special education in Cobb County schools and in North Carolina
9 before becoming an instructional lead teacher for Cobb County; and

10 WHEREAS, because of her commitment to King Springs Elementary School, she has
11 received many awards including: Platinum School for High Achievement in 2009, Georgia
12 School of Excellence for Academic Achievement in 2012, and National PTA School of
13 Excellence for Parental Involvement from 2014-2018; and

14 WHEREAS, she has led King Springs Elementary School to grow from 625 students to 948
15 students split between two elementary school campuses; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
17 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend Linda Keeney for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
20 leadership and service to the State of Georgia and extend to her their most sincere best
21 wishes for continued health and happiness.
