A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide for the compensation of the judges of the State Court of Fulton  
2 County, the judges of the Juvenile Court of Fulton County, and the judge of the Probate  
3 Court of Fulton County, approved April 19, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3904), so as to modify the  
4 compensation of the judges of the State Court of Fulton County; to provide for related  
5 matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to provide for the compensation of the judges of the State Court of Fulton County,  
9 the judges of the Juvenile Court of Fulton County, and the judge of the Probate Court of  
10 Fulton County, approved April 19, 2000 (Ga. L. 2000, p. 3904), is amended by revising  
11 Section 1 as follows:

12 "SECTION 1.

13 (a) Each of the judges of the Juvenile Court of Fulton County and the judge of the Probate  
14 Court of Fulton County shall be paid an annual salary equal to 90 percent of the total of the  
15 state salary plus the county supplement now or hereafter paid to a judge of the Superior Court  
16 of Fulton County. Such salaries shall be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds  
17 of Fulton County. This section shall not affect, reduce, or repeal any sum payable in addition  
18 to compensation as provided by local law to the chief judge of the State Court of Fulton  
19 County for performing the duties of chief judge.

20 (b) Each of the judges of the State Court of Fulton County shall be paid an annual salary  
21 equal to 95 percent of the total of the state salary plus the county supplement now or  
22 hereafter paid to a judge of the Superior Court of Fulton County. Such salaries shall be paid  
23 in equal monthly installments from the funds of Fulton County. This section shall not affect,  
24 reduce, or repeal any sum payable in addition to compensation as provided by local law to  
25 the chief judge of the State Court of Fulton County for performing the duties of chief judge."

26 **SECTION 2.**

27 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2018.

28 **SECTION 3.**

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
