

The House Committee on Judiciary Non-Civil offers the following substitute to SB 250:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 42-1-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 restrictions on registered offenders residing, working, or loitering within certain distances  
3 of child care facilities, churches, schools, or areas where minors congregate, so as to apply  
4 loitering restrictions to individuals registered as sexual offenders in other states who are  
5 visiting this state; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other  
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 42-1-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to restrictions on  
10 registered offenders residing, working, or loitering within certain distances of child care  
11 facilities, churches, schools, or areas where minors congregate, is amended by revising  
12 subsection (d) as follows:

13 "(d) Notwithstanding any ordinance or resolution adopted pursuant to Code Section  
14 16-6-24 or subsection (d) of Code Section 16-11-36, it shall be unlawful for any individual  
15 or for any person who is registered on another state's sexual offender registry to loiter, as  
16 prohibited by Code Section 16-11-36, at any child care facility, school, or area where  
17 minors congregate."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
