Representative Fleming of the 121st et al. offer the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate substitute to HB 268 (LC 28 8464S) by striking lines 310 through 318 and*
 2 *inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

3 (E) Other documents or methods of proof that are established pursuant to the federal
 4 Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986 (P. L. 99-603);

5 (F) The applicant's Bureau of Indian Affairs card ~~number~~, tribal treaty card ~~number~~,
 6 or tribal enrollment ~~number~~ card; and

7 (G) For residents of this state who are United States citizens but are not in possession
 8 of any of the documents or methods of proof enumerated under subparagraphs (A)
 9 through (F) of this paragraph, other documents or methods of proof for establishing
 10 evidence of United States citizenship which shall be promulgated by rule and regulation
 11 of the State Election Board."

12 *By striking lines 330 and 331 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

13 voter registration application upon penalty of law and such application shall be processed
 14 without regard to the procedures outlined in subsections (b), (c), and (d) of this Code
 15 section.

16 (b) For those voter registration applicants who have a Georgia driver's license number or
 17 identification card number for an identification card issued pursuant to Article 5 of
 18 Chapter 5 of Title 40, or the last four digits of a social security number, a voter registration
 19 application may be accepted as valid only after the board of

25 verified and that the applicant must provide sufficient evidence to the board of registrars
 26 to verify the applicant's identity in order to have his or her application processed by the

29 sufficient evidence to the board of registrars to verify the applicant's identity, by the end
30 of the time period set forth in subsection (c) of Code Section 21-2-419.

31 *By striking lines 377 through 381 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

32 applicant is not verified and the applicant fails to present sufficient evidence to the board
33 of registrars to verify the applicant's identity within 26 months following the date of the
34 application.

35 *By striking lines 596 through 598 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

36 for any petition or conduct any exit poll or public opinion poll with voters, nor shall any
37 person, other than election officials discharging their duties, establish or set up any tables
38 or booths on any day in which ballots are being cast:
