A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the West Fulton High School Class of 1967 and the Class of 1966's 50th
2 Reunion; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, members of the West Fulton High School Class of 1967 and the Class of 1966
4 will host reunion activities June 9-11 of 2017 to celebrate their 50th class reunion; and

5 WHEREAS, the 1967 Graduating Class entered the halls of West Fulton High School in the
6 fall of 1964; and

7 WHEREAS, the Class of 1967 are the "Legends of West Fulton," because they were the first
8 largest majority black graduating class with a total of 149 graduates: 144 black graduates,
9 and five white graduates; and

10 WHEREAS, in 1967, the Flying Rifles Drill Team competed in both city-wide and
11 state-wide competition, finishing first place in both levels, and the Class of 1967 members
12 were Commander Michael Lewis, Johnny Clark, Larry Geer, James Harris, and Leo Walker;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, West Fulton High School has a proud history and an alumni base that has
15 contributed greatly to the spirit, growth, and progress of Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, this 50th year reunion celebration for the 1967 and 1966 graduating class of
17 West Fulton High School is a joyous occasion for old friends to be remembered and old
18 memories and friendships to be refreshed.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 recognize the West Fulton High School Class of 1967 and Class of 1966 on their 50th
21 reunion.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
