

Senators Jones of the 25th, Mullis of the 53rd, Jeffares of the 17th, Hufstetler of the 52nd, McKoon of the 29th and others offered the following amendment:

ADOPTED

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Regulated Industries and Utilities Committee substitute to*
 2 *HB 205 (LC 36 3380ERS) by striking line 7 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

8 Code Section 12-8-39 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to landfill cost
 9 reimbursement fees and surcharges, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows:

10 "(d) Effective ~~January 1, 1992~~, July 1, 2017, when a municipal solid waste disposal facility
 11 is operated by private enterprise, the host local government is authorized and required to
 12 impose a surcharge of ~~\$1.00~~ \$3.00 per ton or volume equivalent in addition to any other
 13 negotiated charges or fees which shall be imposed by and paid to the host local government
 14 for the facility and shall be used to offset the impact of the facility, public education efforts
 15 for solid waste management, the cost of solid waste management, and the administration
 16 of the local or regional solid waste management plan; provided, however, that such
 17 surcharges may be used for other governmental expenses to the extent not required to meet
 18 the above or other solid waste management needs."
