A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Jamel D. Chambers, the 2017 Georgia Legislative Black Caucus Intern of the
2 Year; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Georgia Legislative Black Caucus (GLBC) internship program is one of the
4 nation's oldest educational internships to focus on the state legislative process and the
5 nation's largest Black Caucus; and

6 WHEREAS, the internship program is a cooperative venture between the Georgia General
7 Assembly and institutions of higher learning in Georgia, and it provides a select group of
8 students in-depth exposure to the House of Representatives and the Senate by assigning them
9 to assist key standing committees and legislative leaders; and

10 WHEREAS, the 40 students selected for the GLBC intern program represent some of the
11 best and the brightest college students in our state who share a genuine interest in the
12 lawmaking process and potential commitment to public service; and

13 WHEREAS, participants in this outstanding program are students from Morehouse College,
14 Spelman College, Clark Atlanta, Savannah State University, and Georgia State University;

16 WHEREAS, the unique experience of participating as House Interns has undoubtedly
17 enriched the academic study these college students have completed; and

18 WHEREAS, Jamel D. Chambers has performed admirably in the areas of appropriations,
19 constituent services, researching Senate legislation, and drafting bills, and it is abundantly
20 fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this extraordinary individual be
21 appropriately recognized.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 commend Jamel D. Chambers on being named the 2017 Georgia Legislative Black Caucus
24 Intern of the Year and extend best wishes for his continued success.
