Senator McKoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Public Safety substitute to HB 136 (LC 41 1151S) by*  
 2 *replacing lines 3 through 5 with the following:*

3 to provide that no person shall be issued certain licenses or permits without surrendering  
 4 certain previously issued licenses or permits; to provide for exceptions; to revise provisions  
 5 pertaining to the surrender of certain previously issued licenses and permits by noncitizens;  
 6 to provide for receipt upon confirmation of eligibility for

7 *By replacing lines 23 through 56 with the following:*

8 "(c)(1) Any person who applies for a driver's license, instruction permit, or limited  
 9 driving permit shall indicate on such application whether he or she is in possession of any  
 10 other valid driver's license or permit issued pursuant to this title or from any other  
 11 jurisdiction. Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection and in Code Section  
 12 40-5-32, no

13 (2) No person shall receive a driver's license unless and until such person surrenders to  
 14 the department all valid licenses or permits in such person's possession issued to him or  
 15 her by this pursuant to this title or by any other jurisdiction. All surrendered licenses  
 16 issued by another jurisdiction shall be destroyed. The license information shall be  
 17 forwarded to the previous jurisdiction. No person shall be permitted to have more than  
 18 one valid driver's license at any time.

19 ~~(2) Any noncitizen who is eligible for issuance of a driver's license pursuant to the~~  
 20 ~~requirements of this chapter may be issued a driver's license without surrendering any~~  
 21 ~~driver's license previously issued to him or her by any foreign jurisdiction. This~~  
 22 ~~exemption shall not apply to a person who is applying for a commercial driver's license~~  
 23 ~~or who is required to terminate any previously issued driver's license pursuant to federal~~  
 24 ~~law. The department shall make a notation on the driving record of any person who~~  
 25 ~~retains a foreign driver's license, and this information shall be made available to law~~  
 26 ~~enforcement officers and agencies on such person's driving record through the Georgia~~  
 27 ~~Crime Information Center."~~

28 *By replacing lines 158 through 162 with the following:*

29 "(c)(1) No person may possess more than one identification card issued pursuant to this  
 30 Code section; provided, however, that this subsection shall not be construed to prevent  
 31 a resident of this state who possesses a driver's license, instruction permit, or limited

32 driving permit pursuant to this title from also possessing an identification card issued  
33 under this article.

34 *By replacing lines 167 through 196 with the following:*

35 (B) Each ~~Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection,~~ each applicant for an  
36 identification card shall surrender to the department any valid identification card ~~or,~~  
37 driver's license, instruction permit, or limited driving permit previously issued pursuant  
38 to this title or by any other state ~~and any identification card previously issued by this~~  
39 state jurisdiction.

40 (C) The department shall issue a receipt to a person eligible to be issued an  
41 identification card pursuant to the requirements of this title. Such receipt may be used  
42 as proof of issuance until the person has received his or her permanent identification  
43 card.

44 (D) If a surrendered identification card, driver's license, instruction permit, or limited  
45 driving permit was issued by another jurisdiction, the department shall forward the  
46 surrendered card, license, or permit information to the previous jurisdiction.

47 ~~(3)(A) Any noncitizen who is eligible for issuance of an identification card pursuant~~  
48 ~~to the requirements of this chapter may be issued an identification card without~~  
49 ~~surrendering any driver's license or identification card previously issued to him or her~~  
50 ~~by any foreign jurisdiction. This exemption shall not apply to a person who is required~~  
51 ~~to terminate any previously issued identification card pursuant to federal law.~~

52 ~~(B) The department shall make a notation on the driving record of any person who~~  
53 ~~retains a foreign identification card or driver's license, and this information shall be~~  
54 ~~made available to law enforcement officers and agencies on such person's driving~~  
55 ~~record through the Georgia Crime Information Center.~~

56 ~~(4)~~ Willful failure to surrender any such previous driver's license or personal  
57 identification card upon application for a new personal identification card will be  
58 considered an act of fraud and upon conviction be punished as provided for in Code  
59 Section 40-5-125."
