A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Felix King Eiremiokhae; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Felix King Eiremiokhae is from a very humble background, born to the family
3 of Mr. and Mrs. David Eraga Eiremiokhae on March 17, 1970, in Afuda, a small village in
4 Esan Central Local Government Area of Edo, Nigeria; and

5 WHEREAS, Felix grew up in a community where severe childhood poverty was ever
6 present, and through the power of faith and hope, he was able to overcome countless
7 obstacles to become a successful entrepreneur and philanthropist; and

8 WHEREAS, he incorporated Oracle Experience Limited, a multiple award winning
9 advertising and marketing agency that provide events, marketing, planning, and sponsorship
10 services to several local and multinational companies with satellite operations in Nigeria and
11 Mayor Biscuits Company Limited (MABISCO), a confectionaries and foods company that
12 produces, markets, and distributes freshly baked biscuits across Nigeria with plans to expand
13 its exports to many other countries across the continent of Africa; and

14 WHEREAS, through his business concerns and by dint of hard work, perseverance,
15 dedication, and drive, Felix has been able to provide employment opportunities to nearly
16 1,000 individuals with steady and regular income for themselves and their families; and

17 WHEREAS, with the support of his wife, he started the Felix King Charity Foundation with
18 the key objective of giving hope to poor and vulnerable widows and their children in
19 communities across Nigeria. The foundation has touched the lives of more than 1,000
20 vulnerable widows and 3,000 children across Nigeria, transforming their lives from ones of
21 despair to hope through different aid programs; and

22 WHEREAS, on June 21, 2017, the Felix King Foundation presented a private bill for the
23 protection of widows, orphans, and disadvantaged women from maltreatment and other allied

24 matters to the Edo State House of Assembly, Nigeria, and he remains very hopeful that the
25 bill will be passed into law; and

26 WHEREAS, apart from his businesses and charity work, Felix is a devoted family man who
27 is loved by many and happily married to Aderonke Eiremiokhae, and they are blessed with
28 four amazing children, Omonzele, Zion, Great, and Shiloh-Chicago; and

29 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
30 remarkable individual be appropriately recognized.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
32 commend Felix King Eiremiokhae for his many valuable contributions on behalf of those in
33 need and extend best wishes for continued success.
