## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Chattahoochee District on being named the Georgia  
2 Forestry Commission's 2017 District of the Year; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the mission of the Georgia Forestry Commission is to provide leadership,  
4 service, and education in the protection and conservation of Georgia's forest resources; and

5 WHEREAS, each year, one forestry district is selected as the Georgia Forestry Commission's  
6 District of the Year based on measures of accomplishments that include customer  
7 satisfaction, fire prevention efforts, number of miles of firebreaks plowed and harrowed,  
8 acres of prescribed burning accomplished, training hours logged, equipment and facility  
9 appearance, reforestation efforts, and landowner forest management plans completed; and

10 WHEREAS, due to these outstanding accomplishments of the Chattahoochee District in the  
11 year 2017, the district was selected as the Georgia Forestry Commission's District of the  
12 Year; and

13 WHEREAS, the accomplishments of the Chattahoochee District are a clear indication of the  
14 hard work, dedication, and teamwork present in the district; the ability of district personnel  
15 to meet increased demand for services across the district, state, and country by working  
16 together with fewer resources; and of the continued loyalty of the Chattahoochee District to  
17 landowners, citizens, and communities and the Georgia Forestry Commission; and

18 WHEREAS, the accomplishments of the Chattahoochee District bring great pride to the  
19 professionals of the district, the citizens of the district, the Georgia Forestry Commission, and  
20 the entire State of Georgia.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
22 the members of this body recognize and commend the Chattahoochee District on being  
23 named the Georgia Forestry Commission's 2017 District of the Year.
