A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the Rome High School Wolves football team for winning the 2017 GHSA
2 5A State Football Championship; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Rome High School Wolves football team completed their season with a
4 record of 15-0 and now have won 27 consecutive games; and

5 WHEREAS, the team scored 758 points to become the highest scoring team in the history
6 of Georgia in all classifications; and

7 WHEREAS, the Rome Wolves football team averaged over 50 points per game this season
8 and 46.2 points per game in the playoffs; and

9 WHEREAS, the Rome football team defeated previously undefeated Warner Robins by a
10 score of 38-0 in the state championship game played at Warner Robins; and

11 WHEREAS, Max Preps ranked the Rome football team the number one team in Georgia in
12 all classifications and the number 21 team in the nation; and

13 WHEREAS, Coach John Reid and his staff are in their third year of coaching at Rome High
14 School and have now won two consecutive state championships; and

15 WHEREAS, in recognition of their phenomenal performance, Coach Reid was named Coach
16 of the Year for the Georgia 5A division, Adam Anderson was named Player of the Year in
17 Georgia for all classifications, and seven Rome football players were named to the Georgia
18 5A state team; and

19 WHEREAS, the Rome High School Wolves football program and its players, coaches,
20 managers, support staff, band, cheerleaders, and booster club represent the entire Rome
21 community with pride and dignity while achieving excellence both on and off the field.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 congratulate this great achievement and the spirit of dedication, unity, and community pride
24 that the Rome High School Wolves football team displayed in winning the 2017 GHSA 5A
25 State Football Championship title.
