## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Captain Corry Paul Tyler and dedicating an interchange in his memory; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, United States Army Captain Corry Paul Tyler was born on December 12, 1977,  
4 in Atlanta, Georgia, and graduated from Camden County High School in 1995; and

5 WHEREAS, he earned a bachelor's degree from the United States Military Academy at West  
6 Point and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the Army Aviation after graduation;  
7 and

8 WHEREAS, Captain Tyler served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with  
9 three tours in Iraq in 2003, 2006, and 2007; and

10 WHEREAS, on August 22, 2007, while deployed in Multaka, Iraq, Captain Tyler, along  
11 with 13 others, made the ultimate sacrifice when their Black Hawk helicopter crashed during  
12 a nighttime mission; and

13 WHEREAS, Captain Tyler's service was recognized with numerous decorations including  
14 two Bronze Stars, three Army Commendation medals, two National Defense Service medals,  
15 the Air Medal, Valorous Unit Award, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism  
16 Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terror Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas  
17 Service Ribbon, Air Assault Badge, and Army Aviator Badge; and

18 WHEREAS, Captain Tyler embodied the spirit of service, willing to find meaning in  
19 something greater than himself, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable  
20 and distinguished American be recognized appropriately by dedicating an interchange in his  
21 memory.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
23 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the interchange at Interstate 95 and Exit 14 in Camden  
24 County is dedicated as the Army Captain Corry Paul Tyler Memorial Interchange.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
26 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Army Captain Corry Paul  
27 Tyler Interchange.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
29 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
30 family of Captain Corry Paul Tyler and to the Department of Transportation.
