A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Horace L. Dunahoo and dedicating a bridge in his memory; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Horace L. Dunahoo came from a family with deep roots in the field of land
4 surveying; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Dunahoo's passion for land surveying began as a young boy and was said
6 to have been inspired by his uncle, Lucious House, who served as a county surveyor in
7 Barrow County, Georgia, in the early 1900s; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Dunahoo was appointed by Governor Ellis Arnold to survey the county line
9 dividing Gwinnett and DeKalb counties; and

10 WHEREAS, a well-respected surveyor in both Georgia and South Carolina, Mr. Dunahoo
11 surveyed the 32 mile line known as the Old Hightower Indian Trail and prepared maps that
12 defined the line for future generations; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
14 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his memory.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
16 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on State Route 11 at the Barrow/Walton County
17 line is dedicated as the Horace L. Dunahoo Memorial Bridge.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
19 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Horace L. Dunahoo Memorial
20 Bridge.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
22 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
23 family of Mr. Horace L. Dunahoo and to the Department of Transportation.
