A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Reverend Larry Fryer; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Larry Fryer has demonstrated his commitment to teaching the Gospel,
3 witnessing Christ through word and deed, and addressing the physical, psychological,
4 intellectual, and spiritual needs of others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a native of Macon, Georgia, Reverend Fryer serves as pastor of Hudson
6 Memorial Christian Methodist Episcopal Church in Augusta, Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this servant-leader is known for his commitment to nonviolence, justice, and
8 equality and for actively engaging with people at all levels, raising thousands of dollars for
9 students and others in need, and advocating for incarcerated youths and adults; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously works to improve the lives of others, serving
11 with various community organizations such as the Augusta Interfaith Coalition and the
12 Augusta Public Transit Advisory Committee and advising local, state, and national leaders;

- 14 WHEREAS, Reverend Fryer founded the Augusta branch of the Southern Christian
15 Leadership Conference in 2010 and is on the national board of One Church, One School; and
- 16 WHEREAS, whether the task is preparing a sermon, visiting the sick, counseling the
17 troubled, baptizing a new believer, or acting as a theologian, educator, administrator, or
18 humanitarian, Reverend Fryer serves as a shining example of God's righteous path; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the unmatched spiritual assistance offered by Reverend Fryer is a source of
20 strength and direction for persons in all walks of life; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this enduring example of God's message
22 of peace and love be recognized for his innumerable good works rendered on behalf of
23 persons in need.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body recognize and commend Reverend Larry Fryer for his exemplary
26 display of servant leadership and extend best wishes for many more years of successful
