A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February 6, 2018, as Girls Inc. Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Girls Inc. is a nonprofit organization dedicated to inspiring all girls to be
3 powerful, intelligent, and brave individuals; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the organization serves more than 180,000 young women across the United
5 States and Canada, providing guidance for navigating the unique challenges facing women
6 today; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Links, Inc., an international, nonprofit corporation established in 1946,
8 with locations spread across 41 states and Washington, D.C., calls upon its members to work
9 together with community leaders and organizations in order to promote the empowerment
10 of women on the local level; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in partnership with the Columbus chapter of The Links, Inc., the Columbus
12 affiliate of Girls Inc. encourages the growth of leadership skills for girls across the state
13 through the facilitation of unique educational experiences, such as those centered on state and
14 local government relations; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Girls Inc. is providing young women with the opportunities they need to gain
16 valuable insight into significant issues that are affecting our state and supplying them with
17 the confidence they need to succeed in the future; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this exceptional organization be further
19 recognized for its positive impact on the lives of the women inhabiting this state.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
21 the members of this body recognize February 6, 2018, as Girls Inc. Day at the state capitol.
