

Senate Bill 398

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act reconstituting the Board of Education of Talbot County, approved April
2 5, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4710), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 27, 1995
3 (Ga. L. 1995, p. 3541), so as to provide for compensation of the members of the Board of
4 Education of Talbot County; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act reconstituting the Board of Education of Talbot County, approved April 5, 1993 (Ga.
9 L. 1993, p. 4710), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 27, 1995 (Ga. L.
10 1995, p. 3541), is amended by deleting subsection (c) of Section 4.

11 **SECTION 2.**

12 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 6 as follows:

13 **"Section 6.** Each member of the Board of Education of Talbot County shall be
14 compensated in the amount of \$200.00 for each day of attendance at meetings of the board
15 and while meeting and traveling within or outside the state as a member of a committee of
16 the board on official business first authorized by a majority of the board. In addition, each
17 member of the board shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual expenses necessarily
18 incurred in connection with travel outside of Talbot County on official business of the
19 board of education, including, but not limited to, attending training sessions or state-wide
20 meetings; provided, however, that such travel is authorized by a majority vote of the
21 members of the board of education prior to such travel. All expenses shall be approved and
22 verified prior to reimbursement in such manner as may be specified by the board. Each
23 board member shall be entitled to participate in any school district group insurance plan to
24 the extent authorized in Code Section 20-2-55 of the O.C.G.A."

25 **SECTION 3.**

26 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
27 it is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

28 **SECTION 4.**

29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
