1 Recognizing and commending Judge Frank J. Jordan, Jr., on the occasion of his retirement;

4 community of Talbot County, Georgia, for the vital role that he has played in leadership and
5 his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, a graduate of Mercer University School of Law, Judge Jordan served as
7 Superior Court Judge in the Chattahoochee Judicial Circuit since 2000, the longest serving
8 Superior Court Judge in the Circuit; and

9 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
10 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced
11 dramatically by his superlative service as a superior court judge; and

12 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience
13 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this
14 state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

15 WHEREAS, his leadership and guidance have been invaluable to the State of Georgia, where
16 he has served on a variety of boards, councils, and commissions during his legal career; and

17 WHEREAS, during his distinguished career, Judge Jordan has served as Chairman of the
18 Talbot County Courthouse Restoration Committee and Director on the Soil and Water
19 Conservation Board; and

20 WHEREAS, a community advocate for children, Judge Jordan has dedicated his time to
21 improving the educational opportunities for Georgia's youth as evidenced by his
22 long-standing service as a member of the Talbot County Board of Education; and

23 WHEREAS, Judge Jordan has served with honor and distinction with the State of Georgia,
24 and his vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the occasion of his
25 retirement; and

26 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
27 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
29 the members of this body recognize and commend Judge Frank J. Jordan, Jr., for his
30 efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated public service to the State of Georgia;
