2 championship and continued success; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Blessed Trinity High School swim and dive program through outstanding
4 athletic ability, unwavering resolve, and unity of purpose and spirit among each member of
5 the team achieved greatness this season; and

6 WHEREAS, the girls team won their first ever state championship in Class 4A-5A; and

7 WHEREAS, seven of the 12 girls who attended the GHSA State High School swim meet
8 earned All State honors by placing in the top 10 in either an individual event or a relay; and

9 WHEREAS, Rachel Saxon was individual state champion in the 100 backstroke with an All
10 American consideration time; and

11 WHEREAS, in 2017, the girls team suffered a heartbreaking loss due to a false start, but the
12 team remained resolute and won the championship in 2018; and

13 WHEREAS, the boys team secured a fourth place overall finish resulting in a very successful
14 season; and

15 WHEREAS, Dillon Downing was awarded All American honors after he won the individual
16 state championship in the 50 and 100 freestyle and achieved the fastest 50 freestyle time in
17 Georgia; and

18 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding
19 athletic ability and the dedication and hard work of each member of the team.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 commend the Blessed Trinity High School swim and dive program for its outstanding
22 achievements and extend their most sincere best wishes for continued success.
