## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the month of March as Women's History Month and March 19th as Georgia's  
2 Celebrating Women in Public Office Day; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Women's History Month celebrates the significant contributions that women  
4 of all races, ethnicities, and backgrounds have made; and

5 WHEREAS, women play a critical role in the vitality and diversity of our communities, and  
6 are an essential part in ensuring that states are well represented; and

7 WHEREAS, while the twentieth century proved to be a pivotal time for women wishing to  
8 enter politics, women still remain underrepresented in male dominated fields; and

9 WHEREAS, it is imperative that more opportunities are provided in order to support women  
10 in public office, and that awareness is brought to the fundamental necessity of their work.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
12 the members of this body recognize the month of March as Women's History Month and  
13 March 19th as Georgia's Celebrating Women in Public Office Day.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
15 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
16 public and the press.
