

Senators Cowser of the 46th and Tillery of the 19th offered the following amendment:

**ADOPTED**

1 *Amend SB 348 (LC 41 1292) by replacing lines 1 through 3 with the following:*

2 To amend Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, so as to  
3 revise the arrest powers jurisdiction of the campus policemen and other security personnel  
4 of the university system; to revise the powers of arrest of campus policemen who are regular

5 *By redesignating Sections 3 and 4 as Sections 4 through 5, respectively, and replacing lines*  
6 *13 through 14 with the following:*

7 Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, is amended by  
8 revising Code Section 20-3-72, relating to arrest powers of campus policemen and security  
9 personnel, as follows:

10 "20-3-72.

11 The campus policemen and other security personnel of the university system who are  
12 regular employees of the system shall have the power to make arrests for offenses  
13 committed upon any property under the jurisdiction of the board of regents and for offenses  
14 committed upon any public or private property within 500 yards feet of any property under  
15 the jurisdiction of the board."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 Said title is further amended by adding a new Code section to Article 2 of Chapter 4, relating  
18 to technical and adult education, to read as follows:

19 *By replacing "yards" with "feet" on line 22.*

20 *By replacing lines 24 and 25 with the following:*

21 Said title is further amended by revising Code Section 20-8-4, relating to exemption of
