5 daughter of William Rosco Brown and Wilma Rose Cheek Brown; and
- 6 WHEREAS, she earned an associate's degree from Sacred Heart College and she spent her  
7 career as a medical laboratory technician at Rockford Clinic; and
- 8 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Little was an active member of  
9 Morganton Baptist Church; and
- 10 WHEREAS, her leadership and guidance were instrumental to the Union County Lions Club,  
11 where she was honored with the organization's Melvin Jones Award and was inducted into  
12 the Lions Club Hall of Fame; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Little served as president of the American Federation of Republican  
14 Women in Union and Fannin counties and treasurer of the Fannin County Republican Party,  
15 was an associate member of the Gilmer County Republican Party, and a member of the  
16 Daughters of the Confederacy, Joseph Emerson Brown Chapter; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mrs. Little was united in love and marriage to Eugene Little, and was blessed  
18 with two remarkable sons, Edward and William, and three wonderful grandchildren,  
19 Victoria, William, and Alexandria; and

20 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
21 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,  
22 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

23 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Mrs. Little will long be remembered for  
24 her love of family and friendship, and this loyal wife, mother, grandmother, and friend will  
25 be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.
