

Senate Resolution 846

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to limit the number of municipal
2 corporations in the state; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or
3 rejection; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

6 Article IX of the Constitution is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

7 SECTION VIII.
8 MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS

9 Paragraph I. *Number of municipal corporations limited.* There shall not be more than
10 539 municipal corporations in this state."

11 SECTION 2.

12 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
13 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
14 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

15 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that there
16 () NO shall be no more than 539 municipal corporations in this state?"

17 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
18 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
19 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
20 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
