A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for the compensation of the members and chairperson of the
2 Board of Education of Rockdale County, approved March 10, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 3652),
3 so as to modify the compensation of the members of the Board of Education of Rockdale
4 County; to provide for future cost-of-living increases; to provide for related matters; to
5 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act providing for the compensation of the members and chairperson of the Board of
9 Education of Rockdale County, approved March 10, 1988 (Ga. L. 1988, p. 3652), is amended
10 by revising subsection (a) of Section 1 as follows:

11 "(a)(1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, beginning on
12 the effective date of this section, each member, including the chairperson, of the Board
13 of Education of Rockdale County shall receive as compensation for serving on such
14 board \$1,000.00 per month; and, as a cost-of-living adjustment, the amount of the
15 monthly compensation received by such members shall increase in each year by a
16 percentage equal to any cost-of-living adjustment provided to teachers under the
17 jurisdiction of the board of education.

18 (2) Beginning on January 1, 2020, each member, including the chairperson, of the Board
19 of Education of Rockdale County shall receive as compensation for serving on such
20 board \$1,200.00 per month; and, as a cost-of-living adjustment, the amount of the
21 monthly compensation received by such members shall increase in each year by a
22 percentage equal to any cost-of-living adjustment provided to teachers under the
23 jurisdiction of the board of education.

24 (3) The compensation provided for in this subsection shall be paid from the funds of the
25 Rockdale County School System."

26 **SECTION 2.**

27 This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which
28 it is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

29 **SECTION 3.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
