A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life of Mr. Hoyt Dean "Dink" McCoy and dedicating a road in his memory; and
- 2 for other purposes.

- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Hoyt Dean "Dink" McCoy was a lifelong resident of Banks County,
- 4 Georgia, where he was known by many as the mayor emeritus of Bushville; and

- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. McCoy was the owner of McCoy Grading Company and was a passionate
- 6 fan of NASCAR; and

- 7 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Mr. McCoy was an active member of Webbs
- 8 Creek Baptist Church; and

- 9 WHEREAS, he was a loving and devoted father to his daughters, Marsha and Kim, who
- 10 blessed him with four grandchildren and five great-grandchildren, and a supportive brother
- 11 to his sisters, Jean, Nan, and Mary; and

- 12 WHEREAS, a politics buff, Mr. McCoy enjoyed attending the legislature's annual Wild Hog
- 13 Supper and, along with "Boll Weevil" Rylee, is said to have manufactured and delivered
- 14 more nontaxed clear spirits to the Georgia State Capitol than any other Georgian; and

- 15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
- 16 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his memory.

- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
- 18 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 164 from U.S. Route 441 to
- 19 State Route 59 in Banks County is dedicated as the Hoyt Dean "Dink" McCoy Memorial
- 20 Highway.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
22 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Hoyt Dean "Dink" McCoy
23 Memorial Highway.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
25 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
26 family of Mr. Hoyt Dean "Dink" McCoy and to the Department of Transportation.
