## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Senator Edward H. Zipperer and dedicating a bridge in his honor; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Senator Edward H. Zipperer has long been recognized by the citizens of this  
4 state for the vital role that he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to  
5 the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,  
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced  
8 dramatically by his service with the Georgia Senate from 1967 to 1975; and

9 WHEREAS, while in the Georgia General Assembly, Senator Zipperer served on 13  
10 committees and was instrumental in obtaining public recreational areas for Skidaway Island  
11 State Park, Fort McAllister State Park, and King's Ferry Ogeechee River; and

12 WHEREAS, Senator Zipperer's significant organizational and leadership talents, his  
13 remarkable patience and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs  
14 of the citizens of this state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and  
15 associates; and

16 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
17 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished  
19 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a bridge in his honor.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
21 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the bridge on State Route 204 at King George Boulevard  
22 in Chatham County is dedicated as the Edward H. Zipperer Bridge.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
24 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Edward H. Zipperer Bridge.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Senator  
27 Edward H. Zipperer and to the Department of Transportation.
