15 a manner becoming of an Eagle Scout; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
17 set an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 commend Aaron Scott for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded
20 by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of
