A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the TeenPact program; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, TeenPact is a dynamic, hands-on leadership school for Christian students; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the mission of this program is to inspire youth in their relationship with Christ
- 4 and to train them to understand the political process; and
- 5 WHEREAS, TeenPact also aims to teach youth how to value their liberty, how to defend the
- 6 Christian faith, and how to engage the present culture at a time when they typically do not
- 7 care about such things; and
- 8 WHEREAS, TeenPact began in 1994 in Georgia, and now operates in 42 states; and
- 9 WHEREAS, approximately 40,000 students have gone through the program so far; and
- 10 WHEREAS, several alumni of the TeenPact program have gone on to become state
- 11 representatives and successful businessmen and women; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the accomplishments of this exemplary
- 13 program, and its positive impact on the lives of youth across the nation today, be
- 14 appropriately recognized.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 16 recognize and commend the TeenPact program.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
