A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Raybon Anderson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Raybon Anderson was raised on a farm in Nevils, Georgia, and graduated from
3 Southeast Bulloch High School in 1956; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Janelle, on June 10, 1960, and
5 they were blessed with two remarkable children, Mike and Angie; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Anderson is a long-time member of Statesboro
7 Primitive Baptist Church, and it has been said that he is a genuine man of integrity who has
8 always put God in the center of everything he has done, and that he is a leader and problem
9 solver with a servant's heart; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he has served in various elected and appointed roles and capacities over the
11 years, including as chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, the Development
12 Authority of Bulloch County, the Chamber of Commerce, the Georgia Department of Natural
13 Resources, the Georgia Department of Transportation, and several others; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Anderson has garnered a number of awards and honors over the years,
15 including Ag Partner of the Year for 2016; the Georgia Forestry Stewardship Award; the
16 Bulloch County Citizen of the Year for 2011; Statesboro Herald Humanitarian of the Year

- 18 WHEREAS, he is the founder of Bulloch Fertilizer Company, Anderson's General Store, and
19 the president of Raybon Anderson Farms, Inc., founded in 1963; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Anderson noticed a need for an organization that was able to help farmers with
21 all agricultural needs, including fertilizer, ag chemicals, horse supplies, and any other
22 services and products that a farmer could need, all within one location; and

23 WHEREAS, with this motivation in mind, he founded Bulloch Fertilizer Company, garnering
24 loyal customers who have supported him and become like family over the decades; and

25 WHEREAS, he has always believed in being honest and sincere, in serving customers with
26 a smile, and in always following through on what he promises them he will do; and

27 WHEREAS, is it abundantly fitting and proper that the hard work and various achievements
28 of this exemplary Georgian be appropriately recognized.
