1 Honoring the life and memory of Seleta Shaw London Stacy; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Seleta Shaw London Stacy on March 7, 2018; and

8 superlative teaching career; and

11 Chapter for four years; and

12 WHEREAS, she was a pillar of the Camden County community, and she made significant
13 contributions to the Camden County Republican Party; and

14 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Seleta used her musical talents to serve the
15 Lord by singing and playing keyboard and working with children's choirs; and

16 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
17 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
18 her family and friends were admired by others; and

19 WHEREAS, Seleta was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable
20 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made
21 of her life, she made this world a better place in which to live; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Seleta will long be remembered for her
23 love of family and friendship and will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing
24 her.
