## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Anne "Sarge" Barr on the occasion of her retirement and on

4 vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the welfare  
5 of the citizens of Georgia; and

9 Women's Sports League; and

17 and diplomacy, her keen sense of vision, and her sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of  
18 this state have earned her the respect and admiration of her colleagues and associates; and

19 WHEREAS, she is a big proponent of equality and a person of magnanimous strengths with  
20 an unimpeachable reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

21 WHEREAS, Anne has served her community with honor and distinction, and her vision and  
22 unyielding commitment to the Decatur Women's Sports League will be sorely missed upon  
23 the occasion of her retirement; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

27 the members of this body recognize and commend Anne "Sarge" Barr for her efficient,
