A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Captain Glenn "Tex" Brewer; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Captain Glenn "Tex" Brewer on February 23, 2018; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Captain Brewer was born on June 8, 1928, in Tyler, Texas, a beloved son of
5 James H. and Pauline Brewer; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
7 States Navy for 31 years, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans as a
8 photographer, deep sea diver, and submariner; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he received various awards and accolades for his exemplary military service,
10 including a Navy Commendation Medal for being the first person to dive beneath the North
11 Pole, Legion of Merit, Presidential Unit Commendation, Korean Service Medal, and Navy
12 Citation for meritorious action for saving the life of a U.S.S. Tench crew member; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he served with honor and distinction on the Fayetteville City Council from 1991
14 to 2007 and as city manager during the late 1980s; and
- 15 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Jeanne, and was blessed with
17 four remarkable children, Kathaleen, Barbara, Cecilia, and James; nine wonderful
18 grandchildren; five exemplary great-grandchildren; and one incredible
19 great-great-granddaughter; and

20 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
21 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
22 family and friends were admired by others; and

23 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
24 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of his life, he
25 made this world a better place in which to live; and

26 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Captain Brewer will long be remembered
27 for his love of family and his service to this country and state and will be missed by all who
28 had the great fortune of knowing him.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Captain Glenn "Tex"
31 Brewer and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
