

House Bill 1072

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act to provide for a salary and expense allowance for the coroner of Henry
2 County, approved March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 4127), as amended, particularly by an Act
3 approved April 4, 1991 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4415), so as to provide for an annual salary for the
4 coroner; to provide for a salary for the deputy coroner; to provide for related matters; to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act to provide for a salary and expense allowance for the coroner of Henry County,
9 approved March 23, 1977 (Ga. L. 1977, p. 4127), as amended, particularly by an Act
10 approved April 4, 1991 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4415), is amended by revising Section 1 as follows:

11 "SECTION 1.

12 (a) The coroner of Henry County shall receive an annual salary in the amount of
13 \$65,000.00, payable in equal installments from the funds of Henry County. In addition,
14 the coroner shall receive such employment benefits as are received by other employees of
15 Henry County, including, but not limited to, health insurance, retirement plans, and
16 deferred compensation, as applicable.

17 (b) The coroner of Henry County shall be authorized to employ a deputy coroner who shall
18 receive an annual salary equal to \$175.00 per call handled by such deputy coroner, not to
19 exceed \$15,600.00 annually, to be payable from the funds of Henry County. Such deputy
20 coroner shall not be eligible for employment benefits, such as health insurance, retirement
21 plans, and deferred compensation."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
