## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating the City of Morrow on its 75 years of existence; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, beginning as Morrow Station, a stop along the Macon and Western Railroad  
3 Company rail line, the City of Morrow was incorporated on March 2, 1943; and
- 4 WHEREAS, as the home to Clayton State University, the State and National Archives, the  
5 Regional Southlake Mall, the Reynolds Nature Preserve, Spivey Hall, and 7,000 international  
6 residents, the City of Morrow has grown to become a thriving, diverse community humming  
7 with culture and commerce in the 75 years since its incorporation; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the City of Morrow has made the transformation from rural railroad acreage to  
9 a modern arena for lovers of art, music, history, and outdoor recreation that blends its
