12 education and credit counseling, thereby allowing many to have an opportunity to own a
13 home; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Susan led in the development of a homeowner lease and development program
15 and has most recently been responsible for major renovation to the housing authority; and
- 16 WHEREAS, during her time with the Cordele Housing Authority, she was active in many
17 other areas of service to the people of Cordele, including as chair of the Cordele-Crisp
18 County Chamber of Commerce and as an advocate for Habitat for Humanity; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Susan's mission was not only to provide housing, but to provide homes and a
20 better future for those she served; and

21 WHEREAS, through her strong character traits and compassion for those with whom she
22 worked, Susan left a legacy that will challenge generations far into the future.
