A RESOLUTION

2 purposes.

19 Speaker's office to Dianne Hardin; and

20 WHEREAS, Dianne served as executive assistant to the Speaker for over eight years, a
21 tenure that was characterized by her unsurpassed organizational skills, her strong work ethic,
22 professionalism, competence, loyalty, and love for the House of Representatives; and

23 WHEREAS, Dianne has firmly decided that 2018 shall mark her final exodus from the
24 Capitol, after which she will relish babysitting Ava Grace in Panama City and generally
25 enjoying her family with her husband, Bob, and all of her grandchildren, including Hannah
26 and Nathaniel, during her newfound leisure time; and

27 WHEREAS, it is most appropriate to express tremendous gratitude for her 35 years of
28 outstanding service; and

29 WHEREAS, while she will be missed by one and all, hers will be a most deserved
30 retirement.

32 the members of this body thank and commend Dianne Hardin for her service to this state,
