

Senators Ligon, Jr. of the 3rd and McKoon of the 29th offered the following amendment:

13 The legal parents or guardians of a minor child who entered a fantasy contest shall be  
 14 entitled to a private cause of action against each fantasy contest operator that accepted an  
 15 entry fee from such minor child. Such parents or guardians shall be entitled to recover all  
 16 damages available under Georgia law for such violation of this article, including, but not  
 17 limited to, all such entry fees accepted by such fantasy contest operator, all costs incurred  
 18 in the treatment of such minor child for compulsive behavior related to fantasy contests or  
 19 gambling, injuries related to emotional distress, and actual attorney's fees. The remedy  
 20 provided in this Code section shall be in addition to any other right of action or recovery  
 21 otherwise available under law."
