

Senators McKoon of the 29th, Cowser of the 46th, Harper of the 7th, Ligon of the 3rd, Harbin of the 16th and others offered the following amendment:

**WITHDRAWN**

1 *Amend the House amendment to HB 673 (AM 29 2843) by replacing "147" with "158"*  
 2 *on line 1.*

3 *By replacing lines 3 through 5 with the following:*

4 (2) Any person appearing before a court for a first offense of violating paragraph (1) of  
 5 subsection (c) of this Code section who produces in court a device or proof of purchase  
 6 of such device that would allow such person to comply with such paragraph in the future  
 7 shall not be guilty of such offense.

8 (g) Subsections (c) and (d) of this Code section shall not apply when the prohibited  
 9 conduct occurred:

10 (1) While reporting a traffic accident, medical emergency, fire, an actual or potential  
 11 criminal or delinquent act, or road condition which causes an immediate and serious  
 12 traffic or safety hazard;

13 (2) By an employee or contractor of a utility services provider acting within the scope  
 14 of his or her employment while responding to a utility emergency;

15 (3) By a law enforcement officer, firefighter, emergency medical services personnel,  
 16 ambulance driver, or other similarly employed public safety first responder during the  
 17 performance of his or her official duties;

18 (4) While in a motor vehicle which is lawfully parked; or

19 (5) While in a motor vehicle which is at a full and complete stop."
