#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Bruce Bell upon the grand occasion of his retirement; and for

5 citizens of Georgia; and

15 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
16 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

18 recognize and commend Bruce Bell for his efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated  
19 public service to the State of Georgia and this nation; congratulate him upon the grand
