A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County, approved
2 February 8, 1955 (Ga. L. 1955, p. 2064), as amended, particularly by an Act approved
3 April 13, 2001 (Ga. L. 2001, p. 4321), so as to provide the salaries of the chairperson and
4 members of the Clayton County Board of Commissioners; to provide for related matters; to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County, approved February 8, 1955
9 (Ga. L. 1955, p. 2064), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 13, 2001 (Ga. L.
10 2001, p. 4321), is amended by revising subsections (a) and (b) of Section 7 as follows:

11 "(a) The chairperson of the Clayton County Board of Commissioners shall receive an
12 annual salary in an amount equal to the then-current base salary and any cost-of-living and
13 longevity increases of the superior court judges of the Clayton Judicial Circuit plus
14 \$15,000.00, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Clayton County.
15 The chairperson shall also receive an annual expense allowance of \$5,000.00 payable out
16 of the funds of the county and shall be entitled to a county automobile while engaged in
17 county business. The chairperson shall also receive such cost-of-living increases as may
18 be granted to superior court judges pursuant to subsection (b) of Code Section 45-7-4 of
19 the O.C.G.A.

20 (b) The four members of the Clayton County Board of Commissioners other than the
21 chairperson shall receive a salary in the amount of \$35,202.40, together with any
22 cost-of-living increases which have been granted or shall be granted in the future, to be
23 paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Clayton County. The commissioners
24 shall also receive an annual expense allowance of \$3,000.00. The commissioners shall also
25 receive such cost-of-living increases as may be granted to superior court judges pursuant
26 to subsection (b) of Code Section 45-7-4 of the O.C.G.A."

SECTION 2.

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
