- 4 WHEREAS, prior to assuming responsibility for his family's agro-leisure business as CEO,
5 Salvatore worked in the international division of KPMG Peat Marwick in Florence; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in 1990, he interned at Salvatore Ferragamo Spa in the marketing and
7 production departments, where he planned marketing strategies for the company in Italy and
8 France; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he earned an MBA degree at New York University's Stern School of Business,
10 specializing in finance and international business; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in 1993, Salvatore joined his father, Ferruccio Ferragamo, in the long and
12 challenging restoration of the ancient medieval village of Il Borro; in 2012, Il Borro became
13 part of Relais & Châteaux and Salvatore was named ambassador, with the responsibility of
14 representing the excellence and prestige of the organization; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Salvatore has been dedicated to providing unparalleled customer service and
16 support and remains steadfastly committed to the principles of skill, integrity, and
17 responsibility; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
19 extraordinary individual be appropriately recognized.
