

House Bill 209

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 special license plates promoting and supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit
3 corporations with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit
4 corporation, so as to establish a specialty license plate to benefit the Georgia Alliance of
5 Boys & Girls Clubs, Inc.; to provide for related matters; to provide for compliance with
6 constitutional requirements; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and
7 for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

10 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
11 plates promoting and supporting certain worthy agencies, funds, or nonprofit corporations
12 with proceeds disbursed to the general fund and the agency, fund, or nonprofit corporation,
13 is amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (1) to read as follows:

14 "(58) A special license plate supporting the Georgia Alliance of Boys & Girls Clubs, Inc.
15 The funds raised by the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed as provided
16 for in paragraph (1) of this subsection to the Georgia Alliance of Boys & Girls Clubs,
17 Inc."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
20 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
21 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

22 **SECTION 3.**

23 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
24 without such approval.

SECTION 4.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
